6 Meeting Objectives

1. Traffic management planning for DWELP Roads

TB Met with Richard Wardsworth from DELWP, RE the traffic management procedures

DELWP wants to implement a new traffic management plan for all forest users including rallies.

TB was able to arrange some of the details to amend the plan to better fit the rally users.

There is a new plan that is rally specific to us and coves all of the requirement.

The traffic management plan is solely used in the DELWP forests and not on any VicRoads or shire roads.

Tb will arrange a temple for the documents and from July 1 for all events in the second half of the year. This will be DELWP approved.

2. Victorian Rallying Medical Services

Replies were received from MSR but no other providers have responded

Geoff Becker supplied all information requested.

3. Rally boards

4. Gala deposit claim and awards function

Figures for the event 108 attended (2 guests from cams) @40 per head

Expenses \$5060.40

Event did run at a loss. VRCMG will pay some of these losses and have asked VRP to pay \$300 towards costs. This was agreed on and an invoice will be raised

5. 2016 VRC Media invoice

James Elliott has forwarded his invoice for \$850 for media coverage of two events for the VRC the George Derrick and the Akademos. DM was unable to confirm if there would be payment claim for the last round the Begonia?

All are in favour of the payment of the invoice

6. Licences and Olt

TB meet with CAMS today and held discussions re rally OLT. Col Hardinge was able to shed some light on the OLT process which was along the lines of that there is no system currently in place for rally OLT as BW found out in his first enquirer's. TB will reinstate a system for the rally OLT to be held in this year at 4 events and recall a list of OLT assessors and locations that OLT can be held at.

7. Course Checkers for 2018

Panel has proposed to come in line with the rest of the states and the CAMS requirements and will appoint checkers to events in 2018. The COC application will allow them to nominate up to 3 preferred choices but the panel will appoint from those.

8. RP plates information

SLAW will provide to BW information in the 3 steps to getting a RP plated car so the information can go up onto the vicrally website. This will help with the lack of understanding of the process and help to control the information regarding the use and what you can and can't do with RP plated cars.

TB met with cams motorsport manager today and discussed the current standings for RP plate with vicroads.

SLAW noted that vicroads information has been servery lacking for the last few years and he would like to see an improvement in this communications.

TB is arranging a meeting with ambulance Victoria to discuss their concerns with rally's being conducted in Victoria. This is involving the medical planning of events within Victoria Meeting to take place in the next month arranged by TB
