

## SPORTING BULLETIN NCR 150, EQUIPMENT

### REFERENCE:

2003 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, National Competition Rules, NCR 150, Equipment (Page 4-21 & 4-22).

### RATIONALE:

*It was identified that clarification was required in relation to NCR 150 as different interpretations of the rule had arisen.*

*In approving this amendment, the Board of CAMS noted that the existing once per year dispensation outlined in NCR 150 still applies, whereby a competitor can compete in one club or multi-club level rally per year without the necessity to obtain a logbook, upon approval of the relevant State Council.*

### AUTHORITY:

*This amendment was approved by the Board of CAMS at its 97<sup>th</sup> meeting on 9th December 2002 at Minute 3.2.3 [Motion CO3199].*

### ACTION:

Amend NCR 150 as follows:

“..... Section 6 of this Manual of Motor Sport. In addition entrants shall be required to produce at all race meetings, all State level **and higher Speed events, Rally and all Rallies (other than Introductory) and Off Road events**, a vehicle Log Book, properly entered, and issued by CAMS. Notwithstanding .....
