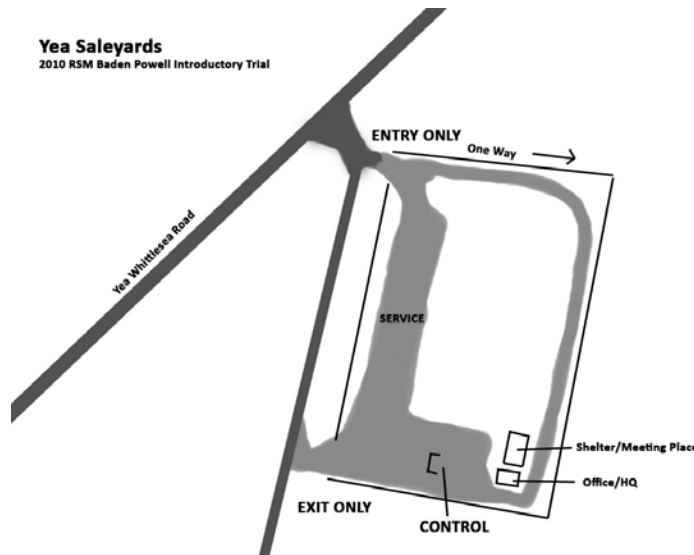

**Report Location:**

The report location is at the Yea Saleyards Office, which is also Rally Headquarters, start and finish of the event. Start, Finish and Service is Located at the Yea Saleyards.



**Rally Headquarters:**

Rally Headquarters will be located in the Yea Saleyards, Flat Lead Road, Yea, and will be open Saturday, August 7<sup>th</sup> 2010, from 1500 to 0330 on Sunday, August 8<sup>th</sup> 2010. This will also be the location for:

- Communications
- Scoring
- The Official Notice board

**Booking - In Procedure:**

A crew member is required to report to the Event Secretary at Rally HQ between the times nominated on page one of these further instructions at the Yea Saleyards Office for checking of event documentation.

A Competitor Pack including route instructions will be issued upon completion of the document check and the presentation of the scrutiny slip at Book In.

If your service crew has a mobile phone, please give the number to the Event Secretary when booking in. This will enable the organisers to contact your service crew quickly should you require assistance.

**Scrutiny:**

Competitors are reminded that there is no scrutineering at the start of the event. Official Event scrutineering will take place on Monday, August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2010 at Bennett Motors, 59 Levanswell Road, Moorabbin.

Scrutineering will be conducted between 1800 and 2100. Cars must be presented in a clean and tidy condition and ready to start the event (with the exception of tyres).

**Crew Briefing:**

The crew briefing will commence at 1730, Saturday August 7<sup>th</sup> 2010 at the Yea Saleyards. The Driver, Navigator and one member of the service crew must attend this briefing.

**Synopsis of Event:**

The event will start from the Yea Saleyards at 1815.

Crews will proceed to nearby forests and compete over three (3) stages covering approximately 50km competitive distance and 50km transport and assembly distance before arriving at Service for a 60 minute service. The first car is due to arrive at approximately 2000.

After the break the crews will proceed back into the forest for three (3) competitive stages covering approximately 50km competitive distance and 50km transport distance arriving back at the Yea Saleyards for the finish. The first car will arrive back here at approximately 2255.

**Servicing:**

Competitors are reminded that they are responsible for the actions of their service crews. It is necessary for all service crew personnel to have their names recorded on the official entry form to be covered by CAMS Personal Accident Insurance. Late inclusions can be notified at book in.

Service crews are reminded that entry to competitive stages to recover vehicles may only be done after the Event Sweep vehicle has cleared the stage, in the case of dual use stages or sections this may be after the second use.

**Odometer Check:**

The survey vehicle recorded 4.99 km between the 'S 35' and the 'S 30' Distance Markers on the Goulburn Valley Highway, starting approximately 3km West from Yea heading towards Seymour.
