NOTES ON THE 2009 VICTORIAN RALLY CALENDAR

1. UNIDENTIFIED PERSONNEL

Events calendared without a Clerk of Course or Checker either failed to nominate suitable personnel or did not nominate anyone at all. Unless a written application nominating a suitable Clerk of Course or Checker for these events is forwarded to the Rally Panel at least 16 weeks before the event in question, the Rally Panel may recommend that the permit for the event be withheld. It is also very unlikely that these events will be re-calendared if suitable people are not found by the original date.

Nominated Clerks of Course and Checkers details which are not shown either requested that their numbers not be published, or did not supply such details.

2. CHANGES IN PERSONNEL

Changes in personnel will be considered provided the Rally Panel receives a written request at least 12 weeks prior to the event. Such request should include details of experience of replacement personnel in order that the Panel ascertain whether the event could feasibly run under the new arrangements.

These requests must also include the relevant officials licence numbers and relevant gradings.

3. RALLY AREAS

All rally areas are listed at the rear of this document, together with a photo-reduced map. Further details concerning areas are available from the respective Area Coordinators, or from the Chief Area Coordinator.

Clerks of Course and Checkers are advised to check the areas allocated to the event as changes may have been made since the application was lodged.

4. NAVIGATIONAL CONTENT

Clerks of Course are reminded that it is mandatory for all closed road Multi-club Non Special Stage events to have a minimum of 50% Navigational competitive stages. All sections of an event are required to be run under road closed conditions (see Section 8).

5. EVENT SPECIAL CONDITIONS

Special conditions, such as running a Multi-club event during the daylight hours or the use of high profile "Super Special Stages", must be approved by the Rally Panel. Applications for such special conditions must be received by the Rally Panel in writing no later than 12 weeks before the scheduled date of the event. Concept notes on the bottom of the event application form are not regarded as an official request as an event often changes as it progresses in its planning.

6. CHANGE OF DATE

Any requests for a change of date must be in writing. It is suggested that the proposed date change be discussed with the Rally Panel Calendar Coordinator by phone prior to formulating a written application. It is Rally Panel policy to only allow date changes if they do not cause an excessive number of events on any weekend and that there is no clash of areas for three weeks either side.

All approved date changes are provisional only until ratified by the DSE.

7. GRADING OF EVENTS

Events have been graded as per the CAMS Ltd. grading system. Details of the system and the associated permit fees are included in the CAMS Manual of Motorsport.

8. ROAD CLOSED CONDITIONS

All competitive sections or stages, regardless of whether the entire section is fully route charted or not, must run under the following Road Closed provisions:

- All access points to the competitive route must be controlled; otherwise the section or stage must be delayed, deleted, or traversed under transport conditions. Effective control is considered to be either a suitable barrier such as a locked gate with appropriate signage or a properly briefed and equipped official.
- Major access points to the competitive areas must have clearly visible signs erected at least two weeks before the event to warn and otherwise advise the public of the intended use and time of use of the area. These signs must be at least A3 size. **A4 is no longer acceptable.** The signs are to be placed as free standing signs, not wrapped around trees or signposts. They must be flat, rigid and weather proof, as a suggestion they could be cable tied between two tall steel droppers. They should not be stapled or nailed or otherwise be fixed to vegetation.

9. POLICE LIAISON EVENT NOTIFICATION

As of 01/06/2004 the following procedure will be adopted in relation to notification to Police.

Six (6) weeks (minimum) prior to a rally, two (2) copies of all details relevant to the proposed course will be forwarded to each of the following;

- The Regional Traffic Inspector in whose region the Rally is to take place and ...
- The Traffic Support Division

The following details must be included in the proposal, in conjunction with the Event Management Plan.

- Date and time of the event
- Organising Club
- Permit Number
- Anticipated number of competitors
- Clerk of Course's address and phone number/s
- Route details, with map and itinerary (Maps to 1:100,000 scaled highlighted both competitive and transport routes), also the location of all major controls and anticipated road closures.
- If 1:100,000 are too small to include all details of competitive sections, a detailed map of each section is to be provided.
- To allow even organisers to meet emergency services (i.e. fire, Police, ambulance etc) and lead them to problem areas, emergency meeting points must be nominated for each event, based on locations from the RACV Vicroads Country Street Directory of Victoria, or relevant regional Country Fire Authority directories. It is the organiser's responsibility to inform the relevant emergency services of the event (date, time, contacts etc) and the location of these meeting

points.

- Copies of permission from other relevant authorities (Shires, DS&E, Vicroads, Private landholders etc) are to be forwarded to the Police with the original proposal, or as soon as they are received.

Copies of the relevant Event Management Plan are available from the CAMS Victorian Office. This will include details of contact locations and numbers for both the Regional Traffic Inspectors and the Traffic Support Division.

Also included are maps and a numbered list of government authorities for relevant corresponding Police region and CAMS areas and the relevant Area Co-ordinators.

Clerks of Course are strongly encouraged to also contact the local Police Stations to ensure that contact through the Regional Traffic Inspector has been made and the local police are aware of the event. This will further relations with the local police and reduce the risk of communication breakdowns interfering with the running of events.

10. AREA CO-ORDINATORS

Clerks of Course must ensure that all correspondence to the authorities is countersigned by the respective Area Co-ordinator. Final Route Instructions must be lodged with the Area Co-ordinator prior to the event or a permit will not be granted.

Any enquiries relating to Areas, Forest Districts, Shires etc., should be directed to the Area Co-ordinator in the first instance or to the Chief Area Co-ordinator nominated by the Rally Panel.

11. OFFICIALS LICENCES

Clerks of Course and Checkers of events are reminded that they must possess at least a Grade 3 officials licence to be able to carry out their duties on calendared events.

NO licence equals NO event permit.
